Wildlife we might get to see: eagles, kites, kingfishers, lapwings, monitor lizards, mud lobster, mud-skippers, horse-shoe crab, nose leaf bats, mangrove pit-viper, crab eating macaque and if we are lucky indo-pacific humpbacked dolphins and otters.
